

RETIREE BLACK LAKE RETREAT June 30 – July 3, 2024

TO: ALL UAW REGION 1A RETIREE CHAPTER CHAIRPERSONS, LOCAL UNION PRESIDENTS AND FINANCIAL SECRETARIES

Greetings:

As captioned above, reservations have been made at the Walter & May Reuther Family Education Center for the 2024 UAW Region 1A Retiree Black Lake Retreat.

Rates for the retreat are as follows:

- Single Occupancy \$402.50
- Double Occupancy \$275.00 (per retiree)
- Couple Package \$550.00 (per couple)

The package includes room accommodations and all meals, starting with dinner on Sunday, June 30, 2024. (As you know, the Region 1A Retired Workers' Council cannot subsidize retreat/weekends at Black Lake.)

Please indicate those who have a **severe** handicap, keeping in mind there are only a few rooms available near the dining room. We will do our best to place all handicapped on the first floor.

Reservations will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis and the deadline is <u>June 10, 2024</u>. We have been allocated space to accommodate 290 retirees.

It is important that Local Unions collect the money from their members who will be attending. One check, from the Local, should be made payable to: UAW REGION 1A and forwarded to the Region, ATTENTION: NOVA SCHOLLENBERGER, with the enclosed registration form for each retiree. This should also include the \$10 bus fee, for each retiree riding the bus.

We hope all retirees will ride the buses to Black Lake. <u>The cost to ride the bus is \$10 per person</u>. Buses will leave UAW Region 1A on Sunday, June 30, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. You may park your car in the Region's parking lot (West side) where you will return at approximately 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 3, 2024.

No food will be supplied on the bus trip; however, a stop will be made for lunch on Sunday, June 30, 2024. A comfort stop will be made where refreshments are available on the return trip home on Wednesday, July 3, 2024.
